Downtown Restaurants...

1. Altitude Chop House and Brew Pub – Good food, great beer, varied menu. Everything from steaks, chicken sandwiches, roasted chicken, burgers, buffalo burgers, pizza, pasta, and seafood.
2. Home Bakery – Open at 6 a.m. . Come in for your cinnamon roll fix. Breakfast burritos and grilled breakfast sandwiches, sandwiches and soup for lunch, closed for dinner. They also serve Espresso drinks.
3. Coal Creek Coffee – They roast their own beans. They have good sandwiches, soups, some pasta dishes, baked goods, salads. They serve beer and wine.
4. Elmer Lovejoys –Good hearty sandwiches and fries, big salads, soups, large burgers. Beer and wine are served
5. Sweet Melissa's –Great hearty vegetarian food! Good portabella sandwich and nachos, good soup. They have falafel, several pasta dishes, and good quiche. They serve beer and wine.
6. The Overland Restaurant – This place has a varied menu for dinner with pasta, fish, steaks, burgers, sandwiches and soups. They also have a nice wine selection.
7. El Conquistador – Known to locals as “El Con” it is Laramie’s longest standing Mexican restaurant. Try the green chile on your enchilada, the flautas are huge.
8. Jeffery's – They have a very eclectic menu, and most of it is very good. There is Siamese chicken, Thai burritos, pasta dishes, dinner sized salads. They do NOT serve red meat. They have the best desserts in town. Beer and wine are served.
9. El Zarape – This new Mexican restaurant has no seating it is carry out or delivery only. If you like your food hot be sure to ask for some hot salsa on the side.
10. Tommy Jacks – Our Cajun style restaurant serving pasta dishes, fish gumbo, etouffee, steak, chicken and salads. Beer and wine are served
11. Grand Avenue Pizza – Good pizza, pasta, salads and sandwiches. Beer and wine are served

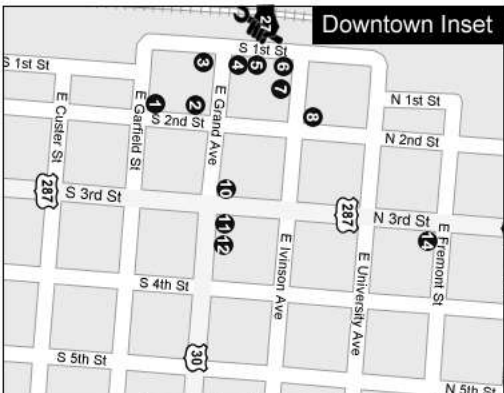
12. Turtle Rock Coffee House – 9th and Clark – A great little coffee house across from the University. Salads, sandwiches, soup and baked goods, breakfast burritos and sandwiches
13. The Grounds – 3rd and Fremont Another coffee place. Salads, sandwiches, soups, baked goods, & smoothies.
14. The Mandarin – North on 3rd St, on the left hand side of the street – Good Chinese food, with a large menu.
15. Teriyaki Bowl – East on Grand across from Albertsons
16. Corona Village – South on 3rd, turn left just before the yellow caboose and follow the road to the end. Huge portions of good Mexican food from a large menu.
17. Andale Rapido – East on Grand, in the strip mall just before McDonalds. The little brother of Corona Village, same great food but comes a bit faster.
18. 17th St. Cafe – Across from the University, behind “The Library” on the south side of Grand. Traditional café food.
19. The Library Restaurant – On Grand Ave. across from the dorms. Steaks, chicken, and pastas.
20. O'Dwyers – Next door to the Library. Same owners as The Library but a more casual atmosphere. It is a brewpub with Guinness on tap. They serve sandwiches, burgers, salads, pasta, pizza, etc.
21. Chelos – A Mexican joint that has been around for a long time. Good food, but no alcohol served.
22. Bernies – Mexican food, just west of the Clark St. viaduct.
23. The Cavalryman – Steakhouse with Prime rib as their specialty.

24. The Pedal House – A major Enduro sponsor. Laramie’s hometown – downtown bike shop.
25. All Terrain Sports – On Grand Ave, just east of downtown.
